
**RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
SINGAPORE RECREATION CLUB and CLUB LUSITANO, HONG KONG**

The undersigned clubs hereby enter into this reciprocal agreement whereby members of each club may use the facilities of the other affiliate club subject to the rules and by-laws of the club and the availability of facilities at time of visit.

1. Neither club is responsible for the acts of its reciprocal affiliate other than for the purpose of providing reciprocal arrangements for its members.
2. The reciprocal arrangements apply only to bona fide members and their family members of the affiliated club.
3. For the purposes of this reciprocal agreement a Club Lusitano member includes full member, Permitted User (corporate and individual) and spouses who hold membership cards.
4. Club facilities will be made available only to reciprocal members visiting our respective cities and not to members who have taken permanent residence or extended residence (over 4 months cumulatively a year) within sixty kms of either clubhouse.
5. Members of one club shall present their **club membership card** along with a **Letter of Introduction** to the other club and thereby have access to all the facilities of the reciprocal club, subject to the payment of any fees that may be charged by the affiliated club.
6. Members of each club shall be entitled to visit the other club no more than thirty (30) days in any calendar year. For the purposes of clarity, the thirty days are to be consecutive days and not exceed more than two block occasions per year (say for examples, a 30-day consecutive period, or one week and three weeks, or two 2-week periods).
7. Guest privileges are subject to the rules, regulations, and policies of the host club. Each club reserves the right to deny or revoke a visitor's privileges at any time.
8. Reciprocal members are permitted to entertain guests subject to the rules of the host club.

9. Reciprocal members are required to settle all accounts at time of purchase or before departure according to each club's payment policy. Neither club will be liable in any manner for costs incurred by their members when using the reciprocal club.
10. Reciprocal members desiring to visit the affiliated club must make arrangements ahead of time through their home club's membership department which shall send a fax, letter, or email to the reciprocal club notifying it of the impending visit.
11. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Singapore. The parties hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Singapore for the resolution of any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement.

This agreement shall become effective immediately upon signature by both Clubs, and shall remain in effect until termination by either Club giving reasonable written notice, defined at least one month in advance, except that pre-arranged commitments such as member bookings of facilities, falling then after shall continue to be honoured.

Procedures for Reciprocal Members visiting Singapore Recreation Club

In accordance with the reciprocal agreement, visiting reciprocal members are required to comply with all rules, regulations, and policies of the host club at all times.

Reciprocal members must obtain a valid **Letter of Introduction** issued by their home club prior to visiting Singapore Recreation Club. Reciprocal privileges are limited to a **maximum of 30 days per calendar year**. Persons residing in Singapore are **not eligible** for reciprocal privileges.

Registration at the Front Desk

Upon arrival, reciprocal members are required to register at the Front Desk for identification purposes. The following documents must be presented:

- Letter of Introduction from home club
- Valid home club membership card

Parking

Reciprocal members may park at Basement 4. Parking charges are as follows:

- \$2.20 for the first hour
- \$1.50 per subsequent half hour up to 6.00pm
- \$4.00 per entry after 6.00pm

Facilities with Restricted Access

Please note that reciprocal privileges do not extend to the following facilities:

- Gym
- Mahjong Room
- Cards Room

Guest Privileges

Reciprocal members are welcome to visit the Club their immediate family members (spouse and dependent children). They are not allowed to sign in any other guests during their visit.

Dress Code

Reciprocal members are required to be appropriately dressed at all times. The following attire is **not permitted** at Levels 1 to 3:

- Workout clothing
- Collarless T-shirts, singlets, tank tops
- Sweaty shirts or T-shirts
- Shirts or T-shirts with slogans, advertisements, or pictorial representations
- Worn-out or frayed jeans
- Patched or cut-out jeans
- Shorts, bermudas
- Slippers or flip-flops

Payment Method

Visa and MasterCard are accepted at selected outlets.

Other Terms & Conditions

Reciprocal privileges are extended at the discretion of the Club and are subject to prevailing Club rules, policies, and availability.
