Reciprocal Agreement

It is mutually agreed between The National Arts Club in New York, (herein after referred to as NAC), and Club Lusitano in Hong Kong as follows:

The following rules, regulations and policy shall apply to both clubs and to their members.

- 1. Reciprocal privileges will apply to all members of each club, however such rights do not extend to those residing in the reciprocal cities
- 2. Such reciprocal use of either club shall be subject to and governed by the By-Laws, Constitution, and House Rules of the host club.
- 3. The reciprocal privileges referred to in this Reciprocal Agreement shall be temporary, and no member of either club will achieve any status or rights as a full member of the other club.
- 4. Upon arrival, visiting members shall be required to provide to the front desk staff a letter of introduction from their home club and a current membership card.
- Members of either club are responsible for making their own arrangements for the use of the other club, including dates of visit, dining reservations, special function arrangements, and all the other requirements of such use.
- 6. All accounts must be settled by the visitor prior to departure. Payment may be made by credit card.
- 7. Both clubs will not be liable in any manner for the cost incurred by their members when using the partner club.

This reciprocal agreement shall take effect when the document is signed by the President or other authorized representative of each club, and termination by either club shall be by way of a thirty day (30) written notice.

THE CLUB LUSITANO FACILITIES AVAILABLE TO THE NATIONAL ARTS CLUB MEMBERS INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

26/F: Fine Dining Restaurant. Combining Portuguese, Macanese and Seasonal dishes. We source most of the primary food products direct from Portugal. Additionally, our extensive wine menu excitingly offers over 200 wines from across the Regions of Portugal. The restaurant is open Monday to Saturday: Lunch served between 12 noon to 3 pm and dinner between 6 pm to 11 pm.

25/F: Pastelaria (café): the Pastelaria Lusitano is the everyday go-to place for members to grab a freshly ground 'Delta' Portuguese coffee and house-made pastries. Breakfast and all-day menus are available. A popular place where members catch up on news and entertainment from our selection of newspapers and magazines, or catch up with work on your mobile device over a snack. Opens daily Monday to Saturday from 8am to 5.30pm (breakfast served between 8 am to 11 am).

24/F: Bar and Lounge: The wine cellar likely holds the widest selection of Portuguese wines within Hong Kong and Macau. Most of the wines on offer are sourced direct from the wine estates themselves and therefore only available in the Region at Club Lusitano. Opens 12 noon to 11pm daily Monday to Saturday.

Library and private function rooms: Available for private events, meetings or social gatherings. Please enquire directly with Club Lusitano on availability and charges.
