New Reciprocal Club Arrangement

Club Lusitano and Aberdeen Boat Club



The President and General Committee is pleased to announce that Club Lusitano has entered into a reciprocity arrangement with the Aberdeen Boat Club (“ABC”).



Club Lusitano members may enjoy the benefits of the reciprocity arrangement with effect from Wednesday, 6 August, 2025.

The Aberdeen Boat Club was established in 1967 and in 1979/80 moved into its current purpose-built premises in Sum Wan Road, Wong Chuk Hang.

The Club has a wide range of facilities for yacht, speedboat and cruiser owners spread over two club houses, with jetty and pontoon moorings available for members' exclusive use. Aside from the recently refitted main clubhouse, they operate a clubhouse on Middle Island with a ferry and sampan schedule, one hundred metres off the southern shore of Hong Kong Island, between Deepwater Bay and Repulse Bay.

The facilities and club activities available to Club Lusitano Members include full access to their main and Middle Island clubhouses (**excluding Sundays and public holidays**) and facilities-

- Restaurants and bar
- Banquet and meeting facilities
- Social events and promotions
- Watersport and sailing programmes
- Sports and recreation including swimming pool, squash, gymnasium, snooker
- ABC Junk hire
- Visitor Parking (Monday to Friday only and at prevailing rates)

Traveling to ABC-

Bus:

1. From Central (Exchange Square): Route 75 - Alight at Shum Wan Bus Terminus
2. From Causeway Bay (Hysan Place): Route 72A - Alight at Shum Wan Bus Terminus

MTR:

Admiralty MTR Station - South Island Line - Wong Chuk Hang Station (Exit B)

Car:

Visitor Parking at the main clubhouse is available during the weekdays at \$100 per first 3 hours and \$50 per hour thereafter and is subject to availability and approval at the discretion of ABC management. Vehicle registration is to be provided at the time of booking.

Other Useful Information for Club Lusitano Members-

- Each Club Lusitano member may visit Aberdeen Boat Club up to three times per calendar month.
- ABC will not accept walk-ins from Club Lusitano members. Advance notification of visits must be made at least 30 minutes ahead of arrival and direct with the reciprocating club during office hours between the hours of 9.00am and 5.30pm Monday to Friday, and 9.30am to 1pm Saturday.
- Each visiting member may bring up to six family members/guests (total seven persons) per visit. The host club however, has the discretion to relax this policy on a case-by-case basis subject to availability.
- The total number of persons accepted by each host club shall not exceed 21 persons per day subject to availability. The host club however has the discretion to vary this policy on a case-by-case basis.
- Membership Cards are to be produced by Club Lusitano member upon request.
- A 17% surcharge shall be applied to each visiting member's chit.
- CL members shall settle their ABC chits only by way of Credit Card (AE not accepted) or Octopus payment card. Cash is not accepted.



Reciprocal Club Arrangement between Club Lusitano and Aberdeen Boat Club Hong Kong

It gives us great pleasure to announce that the General Committees of both Club Lusitano ("CL") and the Aberdeen Boat Club ("ABC") have entered into a Reciprocal Club Arrangement to allow respective Club members to enjoy and benefit from the amenities of the reciprocating Club.

The arrangement and the access privileges are subject to certain Terms and Conditions which are outlined in the attached.

This agreement shall become effective immediately upon signature by both Clubs, and shall remain in effect until termination by either Club giving reasonable written notice, defined at least four months in advance, except that pre-arranged commitments such as member bookings of facilities, falling then after shall continue to be honoured.

**Reciprocal Club Arrangement Between
Club Lusitano and Aberdeen Boat Club
Terms and Conditions**

1. The Aberdeen Boat Club ("ABC") and Club Lusitano ("CL") mutually agree to allow its members the use of their respective facilities including banqueting venues during their normal operating hours up to three times per calendar month per member.
2. Each visiting member may bring up to six family members/guests (total seven persons) per visit. The host club however, has the discretion to relax the maximum number of guests per group on a case-by-case basis subject to availability.
3. The total number of persons accepted by the host Club from the visiting reciprocal club shall not exceed more than 21 persons per day though this shall be subject to availability. The host Club has the discretion to limit or relax the maximum number of reservations and number of visiting reciprocal guests on a case-by-case basis subject to availability.
4. Advance notification of visit must be made at least 30 minutes ahead of arrival and direct with the reciprocating club during office hours between the hours of 9.00am and 5.30pm Monday to Friday, and 9.30am to 1pm Saturday. No reciprocating club shall accept walk-ins, therefore, visits without advance notification / booking.
5. Membership Cards are to be produced by the visiting reciprocal member upon entering the premises or upon request by Club staff at any time whilst on club premises.
6. The management of the host Club has the right to refuse entry or service to any member who visits the reciprocating Club who refuses or fails to produce proof of membership or identification.
7. Chits incurred by the reciprocating Club member must, with the exception of banquet events (which may require an advance deposit), be settled on the day of usage.

8. Payment methods as follows: Both ABC and CL members shall only settle their chits by way of Credit Card (AE not accepted) or Octopus payment card.
9. A 17% surcharge shall be applied to each visiting member's chit.
10. Respective Club members may be invited to partake in host club events, for example, food festivals & promotions, cultural events, concerts, performances, courses, golf days, open days, sailing regattas etc. Additional charges may be incurred.
11. Each member is to respect and abide by all rules and regulations of the host Club these include for example, dress code, use of electronic devices, and are to refrain from offensive or noisy behaviour. The management of each Club has the discretion and right to cancel privileges extended without notice for failure to comply with the host Club's rules, regulations and notices.
12. In order not to disturb other patrons of the club, mobile phones and other electronic devices such as tablets and laptops should be set to silent mode whenever in the clubhouses. Mobile phones may be used only within the lift lobbies of CL and designated lobby areas of ABC.
13. Each member is responsible for the conduct of their guests and shall not leave respective club premises whilst guests remain on site.
14. Club Lusitano members may request visitor parking at ABC on weekdays from Monday to Friday. The vehicle registration should be provided at the time of booking. The charges are \$100 for first 3 hours and \$50 per hour after. Visitor parking is subject to availability and approval at the discretion of ABC management. No parking facilities are available at Club Lusitano.
15. For the purposes of this reciprocal arrangement a Club Lusitano member includes the member, the member's spouse/partner, children between the ages 14 to 17 years old issued with a membership card and Permitted Users and their children between 14 to 17 years old. All bona fide Club Lusitano persons are issued with Club Lusitano Membership or Permitted User cards. An ABC Club Member includes ABC members, the member's spouse, children between ages 14 to 21 years old issued with a valid ABC membership card.
16. The respective General Committees of Club Lusitano and ABC may amend the terms, conditions and privileges afforded as and when mutually decided.
